The DART Summer Research Fellowship Program, housed at the Medical University of South Carolina (MUSC), offers a 10-week summer research fellowship for students interested in learning more about addiction-related research. DART is sponsored by NIH (R25 DA020537) and directed by Sudie Back, PhD. Kathleen Brady, MD, PhD, Sarah Book, MD, Kelly Barth, DO, and Colleen Halliday, PhD, The program is open to undergraduate, graduate, and medical students. 
